


The passing of Lawrence L. Loker – March 23, 2016



Lawrence L. Loker, 86, Blue Springs, Missouri, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 23, 2016. He was born on February 9, 1930 to Nelson and Flossie (Carr) Loker in Berlin, New York.

Lawrence served his country proudly in both the Army and Navy. For 10 years he owned and operated a Graphic Arts company in Washington, D.C. In 1970 he moved to Los Angeles, California where he owned and operated another Graphic Arts company. In 1972 he moved to Kansas City, Missouri where he first worked at the Veteran's Affairs Hospital and later took a job as Program Analyst with the Marine Corp Finance Center, where he retired in 1995. He was a founding member of the Harry S Truman SAR Chapter where he served as president. He was a Charter Member of the Fernando de Leyba SAR Chapter – St. Charles, Missouri. He served as the State President of the Missouri Society of the Sons of the American revolution, the National SAR Society Librarian General, and National Executive Director for four months in Louisville, Kentucky.

Lawrence enjoyed traveling, his favorite trip was a two week long Caribbean cruise with his best friend Gordon Buckner of Marshall, Missouri.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his sister Elsie Loker.
