**Dale Lee Wiseman**, 80, (May 6, 1941 – January 22, 2022) was born on May 6, 1941 to Grady Guy Wiseman and Juanita Mazel Wiseman (nee Emerson). He passed away on January 22, 2022.

Dale was married to his wife Carol on August 11, 1959. They spent 62 years together.
