THIS MONTH IN AMERICAN REVOLUTION HISTORY

Evacuation Day – noon on November 25, 1783 marks the time when the final British departed from New York City. The British Army, British Navy, 29,000 Loyalist refugees, and 3,000 Black Loyalists (former slaves) were all evacuated over a three-month period by orders from London. This day became a general holiday celebrated in New York for over a century until Thanksgiving Day made it redundant. Today, the meaning of Evacuation Day escapes most New Yorkers.
